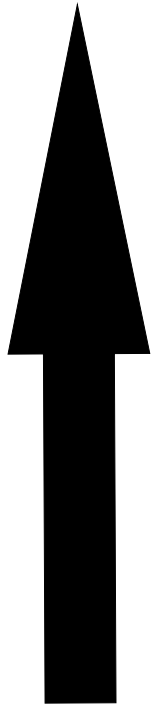




## GRFN EDUCATION LADDER

Below is a description of the EDUCATION LADDER that is referred to and used by this Education Unit when assessing and determining individual applicant's eligibility for post-secondary sponsorship.

*Remember that according to the ISC guidelines, and in order to continue your studies with full-time funding, you must move upwards on the education ladder from your last/current level.*



- 7<sup>th</sup> level: Ph.D Degree** (requires completion of a Master's degree as an admission requirement)
- 6<sup>th</sup> level: Masters Degree** (requires completion of a Bachelor's degree as an admission requirement)
- 5<sup>th</sup> level: Post-Degree** (requires completion of a Bachelor's degree as an admission requirement; i.e. B. of Education, etc.)
- 4<sup>th</sup> level: University Degree** (Bachelor's degree, usually 3 years (General) or 4 years (Honours))
- 3<sup>rd</sup> level: Post-Diploma** (requires completion of a diploma as an admission requirement)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> level: Diploma** (usually two years or more at college)
- 1<sup>st</sup> level: Certificate** (usually one year at college; GAS, preparation type "Pre-" programs)
