

GRFN EDUCATION LADDER

Below is a description of the EDUCATION LADDER that is referred to and used by this Education Unit when assessing and determining individual applicant's eligibility for post-secondary sponsorship.

Remember that according to the ISC guidelines, and in order to continue your studies with full-time funding, you must move upwards on the education ladder from your last/current level.



7th level: Ph.D Degree (requires completion of a Master's degree as an admission

requirement)

6th level: Masters Degree (requires completion of a Bachelor's degree as an admission

requirement)

5th level: Post-Degree (requires completion of a Bachelor's degree as an admission

requirement; i.e. B. of Education, etc.)

4th level: University Degree (Bachelor's degree, usually 3 years (General) or 4 years

(Honours))

3rd level: Post-Diploma (requires completion of a diploma as an admission

requirement)

2nd level: Diploma (usually two years or more at college)

1st level: Certificate (usually one year at college; GAS, preparation type "Pre-"

programs)
